

Mountain Lake Public School Testing Calendar SY 2018-19

September 2018

- September 5-7 – NWEA English – grades K-6
- September 11-14 – NWEA Math – grades K-6
- September 17-21 – NWEA English & Science – grades 7 & 8
- September 24-28 – NWEA Math – grades 7 & 8

Students will test in the subject area classrooms on chrome books or in the computer lab.

October 2018

- October 3 – Pre-Act – 10th gr. students (paper/pencil) (2nd-4th class hrs)

Pre-ACT simulates the ACT testing experience within a shorter test window on all four ACT test subjects: English, math, reading and science.

Results predict future success on the ACT test, and provide both current achievement and projected future ACT test scores on the familiar 1-36 ACT score scale.

- October 10 – PSAT – select juniors (paper/pencil) (2nd – 4th class hours)

Many students take the PSAT, not only as preparation for the SAT taken in senior year and widely used as a major criterion for college admissions, but also to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Competition.

November 2018

- November 6 – ASVAB – 11th grade students (computer) (1st – 3rd class hrs)

The ASVAB Career Exploration program includes an aptitude test, interest self-assessment and career exploration tools. Scores are not released to the military.

January 2019

- January 7-11 – NWEA English – grades K-6
- January 14-18 – NWEA Math – grades K-6

Students will test in the subject area classrooms on chrome books or in the computer lab.
