October 2017

October 4 – Pre-Act – 10th gr. students (paper/pencil) (1st -4th class hrs)

Pre-ACT simulates the ACT testing experience within a shorter test window on all four ACT test subjects: English, math, reading and science.

Results predict future success on the ACT test, and provide both current achievement and projected future ACT test scores on the familiar 1-36 ACT score scale.

October 11 – PSAT – select juniors (paper/pencil) (1st – 3rd/4th class hours)

Many students take the PSAT, not only as preparation for the SAT taken in senior year and widely used as a major criterion for college admissions, but also to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Competition.

November 2017

November 7 – ASVAB – 11th grade students (paper/pencil) (1st – 3rd class hr)

The ASVAB Career Exploration program includes an aptitude test, interest self-assessment and career exploration tools. Scores are not released to the military.

January 2018

Beginning January 29, 2018 – March 23, 2018 – ACCESS for ELL for select
students (online)

The ACCESS and Alternate ACCESS is given annually to English language learners to assess English language proficiency.

The ACT is a college entrance exam that provides MN graduates information related to college and career readiness.
