September 2023

September 25- October 6 - FastBridge Reading & Math - grades K-8

Students will test in the subject area classrooms on chrome books or on iPads. FastBridge tests are given to students in K-8 to measure growth in subject areas during the year, and from year to year.

October 2023

September 25- October 6 - FastBridge Reading & Math - grades K-8

FastBridge tests are given to students in K-8 to measure growth in subject areas during the year, and from year to year. Students will test in the subject area classrooms on chrome books or on iPads.

October 11 – PSAT – select juniors (on computer) (1st – 4th class hours)

Many students take the PSAT, not only as preparation for the SAT taken in senior year and widely used as a major criterion for college admissions, but also to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Competition.

October 27 – Pre-Act – 10th gr. students (paper/pencil) (1st-4th class hrs)

Pre-ACT simulates the ACT testing experience within a shorter test window on all four ACT test subjects: English, math, reading and science. Results predict future success on the ACT test, and provide both current achievement and projected future ACT test scores on the familiar 1-36 ACT score scale.

November 2023

November 7 – ASVAB – 11th grade students (paper/pencil) (1st – 3rd class hrs)

The ASVAB Career Exploration program includes an aptitude test, interest self-assessment and career exploration tools. Scores are not released to the military.

January 2024

January 22-February 2 - FastBridge in Reading and Math for K-8

Students will test in the subject area classrooms on chrome books or on iPads. FastBridge tests are given to students in K-8 to measure growth in subject areas during the year, and from year to year.

January 29 - March 22 - ACCESS and Alternate ACCESS for ELL Students
